

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR JAMES FRANK PHOTO EXCURSIONS

Registration Procedure

Please mail or email the completed registration form along with your deposit to James Frank Photography, Inc. You will receive an acknowledgment of your deposit and registration. You will also receive information on the class scheduling and content, how to prepare for your class, and important "Rocky" area information.

- A fee of \$99 per person is due upon registration, payable to James Frank Photography, Inc.
- There is a 2-person minimum for each excursion.
- As we can accommodate only up to 4 participants per trip, registrations will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.
- Your registration fee reserves your excursion. Excursions are scheduled upon payment in full.
- Pay using a credit card by phone at 970-586-3418, or by check mailed to PO Box 3523, Estes Park, CO 80517
- The fee is fully refundable for cancellations made 7 days prior to excursion.
- No refunds will be granted for cancellations made fewer than 7 days prior to excursion.
- In the event of inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, James Frank Photography, Inc. will, at its discretion, issue a refund or reschedule the excursion.

Physical Requirements

Our time outdoors may require a degree of physical stamina and ability to hike with camera gear at an elevation above 7,500 feet. If possible, schedule your visit to Estes Park several days prior to the excursion. It is important to drink plenty of water and to eat regularly during your stay in Estes Park, and particularly at higher elevations in the mountains. Dress in layers appropriate to the season. Be prepared for any type of weather conditions or temperatures anytime! It sometimes snows in July. Bring jacket, hat, gloves, sunscreen and comfortable hiking boots or similar shoes.

A workshop or class participant should be able to walk with camera gear at least one mile daily. The amount of hiking done depends upon the participants in the group, weather and desired subject matter. However, we don't always hike. Driving excursions with brief walks to spectacular vantage points are always available. By only driving between overlooks very little hiking or walking is necessary. We are happy to cater to special needs if the group allows. If you have any special physical or dietary requirements please discuss these with our staff before applying for a workshop.

Photographic Equipment and Media

Camera formats larger than 35mm are welcome but participants will need the digital or film equivalent of at least a 35mm camera. Point-and-shoot digital cameras are also welcome; however, a sturdy tripod is recommended for best results. You will need a normal lens and plenty of digital media or film. Plan for at least 100 high resolution images (1GB card or more or 3-5 rolls of film.) It is important to have adequate working knowledge and experience with the equipment you bring. If you are considering purchasing equipment or have any questions, feel free to contact us for information and assistance.
